



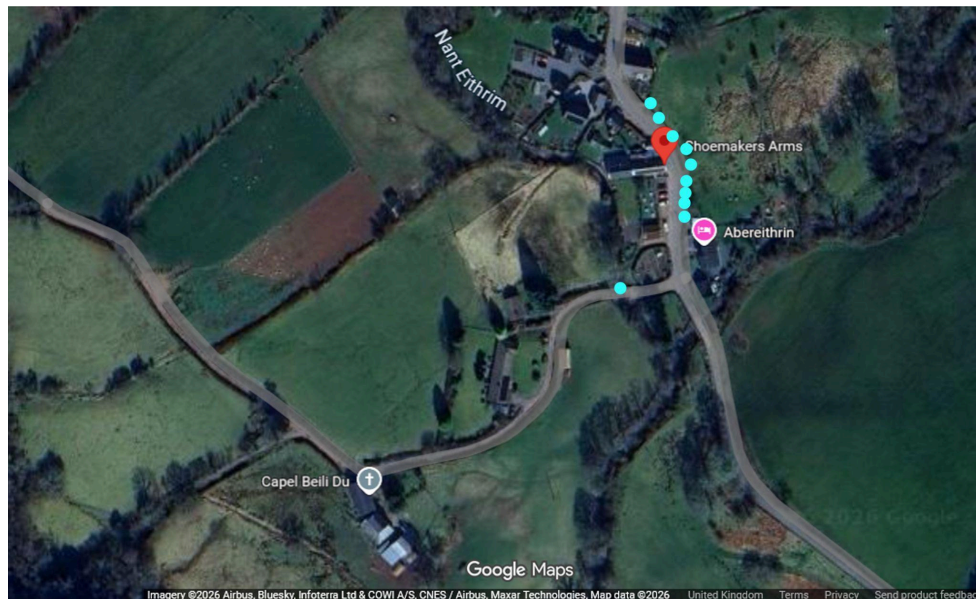
## How to Get Here and What to Bring

I'm delighted you'll be joining us for an experience in the woods - thank you for booking your place.

Woodsong is a 20-acre site just outside the village of Pentre-bach, Powys. If you're coming by car, simply head to Pentre-bach, postcode LD3 8UB. (You can also enter the Shoemaker's Arms in your sat-nav - the pub in the middle of the village.)

The woods themselves are down a track that isn't suitable for regular cars and vans. The track is deeply rutted and uneven, often with nice big water pools, and will likely damage the underside of a regular vehicle.

So we offer free pick-ups from the village of Pentre-bach, LD3 8UB - we'll talk beforehand so I know when you're arriving. Here's a map of the village and where you can park - big blue spots (please don't park in the pub's parking spaces):



If you're coming with a 4WD, you're welcome to park in the woods themselves - there are a few spots on stone available.

Whether you're walking (a 20-25 minute walk from village to woods - small green spots on map) or 4WD driving, here are What4Words references for:

Entrance to the woods: cringe.prevented.niece

Middle of the woods: president.forks.reduce

The closest train stations are Llandoverly and Abergavenny; and the [X80 bus](#) runs 6 times a day between Brecon and Llandoverly - stopping at Sennybridge, which is the closest stop to the woods (a 10-minute drive).

Please let me know if you're coming by public transport and we can arrange pick-ups.

### **What to bring**

The weather changes a lot and quickly here - and rain is never far away. Please bring plenty of changes of clothes, warm clothes, water-proof outer layers, and sturdy, waterproof boots or wellingtons.

We provide protective gloves where needed, and recommend you bring hats and gloves for warmth too.

In the summer months, hats, sun glasses, sunscreen and insect repellent are all advisable.

Please don't forget to bring any medication you may need.

If you're planning to camp, think carefully about what you'll need. That could include: tent & pegs, sleeping bag & mat, pillow, torch, water bottle, toothbrush etc.

On site we have plenty of kitchen, cooking, eating things but - depending on where you're camping, you might want to bring some of that too.
